

All schools receive a grant from the Government to improve the provision of Physical Education and Sport for the benefit of the children so that they develop a healthy lifestyle.

This grant has been used to fund:

A sports teacher coming into school once a week teaching gymnastics - - all children in KS1 and 40 children in KS2.

A sports teacher running after school gymnastics club for year 4/dance club - 15 children.

Various activity days at the Sands Centre – up to 120 KS2 children.

Transport for our residential at Coniston Water Park - 30 children.

Years 3 and 4 swimming in the Summer term - 80 children.

Transport to and from swimming.

This year children in both KS1 and KS2 have benefitted from specialist sports coaching in rugby, gymnastics and team games. This was provided to all KS1 children and 50% of KS2 children.
